Uwekind International School and IB

Uwekind International School was founded in 1997 and is a member of the global International Baccalaureate (IB) community. The school offers an internationally minded education across primary, middle and high school, combining strong academic standards with a supportive and inclusive learning environment.

At Uwekind, different school stages are connected through a coherent educational concept. We ensure smooth transitions between age groups and programmes, while supporting students in their academic, personal and social development. Our school community is built on respect, openness and responsibility, where students, teachers and parents work together to support lifelong learning.

Primary Years Programme (PYP)

At Uwekind International School, the Primary Years Programme (PYP) provides a learner-centred, inquiry-based educational framework for our youngest learners. The PYP nurtures curiosity, creativity and confidence by encouraging students to explore real-world issues through transdisciplinary learning.

Through inquiry, reflection and action, students develop strong foundational skills, critical thinking and a sense of responsibility for themselves and others. The programme places strong emphasis on international-mindedness, student agency and holistic development, supporting children in becoming active, caring and engaged members of a global community.



Middle Years Programme (MYP)

The IB Middle Years Programme (MYP) at Uwekind International School is designed for students aged 11 to 16 and provides a challenging, concept-driven and inquiry-based curriculum. The programme encourages students to make meaningful connections between what they learn in the classroom and the real world. Through interdisciplinary learning, global contexts and project-based approaches, students develop critical thinking, communication and self-management skills. The MYP supports students in becoming independent learners and prepares them effectively for future pathways, including the IB Diploma Programme and the IB Career-related Programme.



Following its mission, Uwekind International School develops the individual potential of its students and fosters international mindsets, educating them as global citizens.

Diploma Programme (DP)

The IB Diploma Programme at Uwekind International School is a rigorous and balanced pre-university programme for students in Grades 11 and 12. It offers a broad academic curriculum across six subject groups and three core components: Theory of Knowledge, the Extended Essay and Creativity, Activity and Service.

The DP encourages students to think critically, manage their own learning and make meaningful connections between subjects and the world around them. Graduates of the programme are well prepared for national examinations and are highly competitive candidates for leading universities worldwide.



IB Career-related Programme (CP) – Candidate School*

Uwekind International School is a candidate school* for the IB Career-related Programme (CP), which is designed for students who wish to combine academic learning with career-related studies. The CP integrates selected Diploma Programme courses with a career-focused pathway and a set of core components that promote personal development, ethical awareness and applied learning.

Through Personal and Professional Skills, Community Engagement, Language and Cultural Studies and the Reflective Project, students develop transferable skills, intercultural understanding and the ability to apply knowledge in real-world, academic and professional contexts. The CP prepares students for further education, training and future careers in a global environment.
